

-tier suppliers. Seller shall require sub-tier suppliers likewise to incorporate documents and requirements in purchase orders to their subcontractors.

- F. Buyer shall have the right to perform in-process inspection, audits, and system verification of conformance to the requirements of this purchase order. Buyer shall have the right to utilize sample inspection methods for acceptance of product. If the sample is unacceptable, Buyer shall have the right to return all or part of the lot for credit or replacement.
- G. Seller shall prepare a Certificate of Conformance (CoC) with each shipment. This CoC shall certify that all items provided under this purchase order meet all requirements of the Buyer.
- H. When Buyer Source Inspection is required, Seller shall comply with the following:
1. the final inspection and test results, as applicable, and the CoC.
 2. Seller shall obtain evidence of Buyer acceptance specified on this purchase order, Seller shall obtain evidence of Government acceptance prior to shipment.
 3. inspection or test, Seller shall perform re-inspection and test of affected characteristics prior to presentation for Buyer acceptance.
- I. Seller shall maintain complete records of all manufacturing, inspection, and test.
