2. FAR 52.222-19, "Child Labor – Cooperation with Authorities and Remedies" (DEC 2001)

3. FAR 52.222-29, "Notification of Visa Denial" (FEB1999)

4. With reference to Paragraph 2, Appendix A, 26th Series, the following clauses related to patents, rights in data, and computer software are incorporated in the Prime Contract:

FAR 52.227-1, "AuthorizationAnd Consent" (JUL 1995).

(3) Foreign sources are those sources (vendors, subcontracts, and suppliers) owned and controlled be a foreign person.

(b) The Contractor shall place a clause in subcontracts containing appropriate export control restrictions, set forth in this clause.

(c) Nothing in this clause waives any requirement imposed by any other U.S. Government agency with respect to employment of foreign nationals or export controlled data and information.

(d) Equipment and technical data generated or delivered under this contract are controlled by the International Traffic and Arms Regulation (ITAR), 22 CFR Sections 121 through 128. An export license is
